APPLICATION FOR FROZEN EMBRYO PERMIT

I hereby acknowledge that I have read and agree to be bound by and follow the AQHA rules pertaining to frozen embryos. I also understand that AQHA will investigate non-compliance with these rules, and in the event of such non-compliance, any resulting foals may be ineligible for registration.

A frozen embryo is a **fertilized** egg flushed from a donor mare that is preserved in frozen storage for purposes of being transferred into a recipient mare at a later date. This form is <u>not</u> to be used to request permits for a frozen oocyte for which there is a separate form. A frozen oocyte is an **unfertilized** egg flushed from a donor mare that is preserved in frozen storage for purposes of being subsequently fertilized and transferred into a recipient mare at a later date.

I understand that one Frozen Embryo Permit is required to register a foal produced using an embryo from a mare not in my ownership. The permit must accompany the registration application.

This application must be signed by both the mare owner and stallion owner to verify the identity of the mare, stallion, and date of fertilization. The stallion owner, if he/she so chooses, may also sign the breeder's certificate on this application to satisfy the requirements for registration for a foal; however, if the breeder's certificate is not signed by the stallion owner, the breeder's certificate section of the registration application must be signed by the stallion owner. Understand that per AQHA rules, if a stallion owner transfers ownership of a stallion whose semen was used to fertilize the embryo prior to satisfying the breeder's certificate and stallion breeding report requirements, then such requirements can only be met by the then current owner of the stallion. The current stallion owner may or may not agree to satisfy the requirements. This is a private treaty between him/her and the owner of the mare owner rights permit attempting to register the foal.

As the mare owner, I understand that if the mare was born on or after 1/1/2015, her stored embryos may not be used beyond two years following her death, I must ensure that a sufficient number of Frozen Embryo Permits are purchased prior to my sale of the mare, and I understand that I must complete an application for each permit needed. Once the ownership changes, I understand that I may no longer purchase Frozen Embryo Permits from AQHA.
